



Application Notes:	The TER-119 antibody is useful for distinguishing erythrocytes and cells in the erythroid lineage. Additional reported applications (for the relevant formats) include: immunoprecipitation <sup>1</sup> , Western blotting <sup>1</sup> , complement-mediated cytotoxicity <sup>3</sup> , and immunohistochemical staining of acetone-fixed frozen sections and formalin-fixed paraffin-embedded sections. Description:	The TER-119 antigen is a 52 kD glycophorin A-associated protein, also known as Ly-76. TER-119 is an erythroid-specific antigen expressed on early proerythroblasts to mature erythrocytes, but not on erythroid colony- forming cells (BFU-E, blast-forming unit erythroid, or CFU-E, colony-forming unit erythroid).
