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Application Notes:

Clone HIP1 recognizes an epitope within the N-terminal region of the GPIb α chain5. Additional reported applications (for the relevant formats) include: immunohistochemical staining of acetone-fixed frozen tissue sections, Westerm blotting, and inhibition of platelet aggregation2. The LEAF $^{\text{TM}}$ purified antibody (Endotoxin <0.1 EU/ μ g, Azide-Free, 0.2 μ m filtered) is recommended for functional assays (Cat. No. 303908).

Description: CD42b is a 145 kD glycoprotein known as gpIbα. It is covalently bonded to CD42c

to form GPIb. CD42b is expressed on platelets and megakaryocytes. CD42b/c heterodimer forms a complex with CD42a and d and acts as the receptor for von

Willibrand factor and thrombin.
